### INTRODUCTION:

God cannot make a mistake because....

- **He knows everything he needs to know**

<sup>5</sup> **Great is our Lord and abundant in strength; His understanding is infinite.** Psalms 147:5 (NASB)

<sup>13</sup> **And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are open and laid bare to the eyes of Him with whom we have to do.** Hebrews 4:13 (NASB)

- **God is always fully aware**
- **God knows everything in time**

<sup>4</sup> **Even before there is a word on my tongue, Behold, O Lord, You know it all.** Psalms 139:4 (NASB)

<sup>2</sup> **And they do not consider in their hearts That I remember all their wickedness. Now their deeds are all around them; They are before My face.** Hosea 7:2 (NASB)

<sup>7</sup> **The Lord has sworn by the pride of Jacob, "Indeed, I will never forget any of their deeds.** Amos 8:7

<sup>36</sup> **"But I tell you that every careless word that people speak, they shall give an accounting for it in the day of judgment.** Matthew 12:36 (NASB)

- **God knows what is in the heart and mind of man**

<sup>21</sup> **Would not God find this out? For He knows the secrets of the heart.** Psalms 44:21 (NASB)

<sup>1</sup> O Lord, You have searched me and known *me*. <sup>2</sup> You know when I sit down and when I rise up; You understand my thought from afar. <sup>3</sup> You scrutinize my path and my lying down, And are intimately acquainted with all my ways. Psalms 139:1-3 (NASB)

<sup>9</sup> "The heart is more deceitful than all else And is desperately sick; Who can understand it? <sup>10</sup> "I, the Lord, search the heart, I test the mind, Even to give to each man according to his ways, According to the results of his deeds. Jeremiah 17:9-10 (NASB)

How should we live in light of God knowing all that he needs to know.

- Come clean with God.

<sup>13</sup> He who conceals his transgressions will not prosper, But he who confesses and forsakes *them* will find compassion. Proverbs 28:13 (NASB)

- Remember that God knows everything when you are tempted to sin.
- Recognize that you are not a mistake.
- Remember that God knows how much you can endure.
