

## **God's Word vs. Man's Word**

### **Luke 14:1-6**

1 One Sabbath, when he went to dine at the house of a ruler of the Pharisees, they were watching him carefully. 2 And behold, there was a man before him who had dropsy. 3 And Jesus responded to the lawyers and Pharisees, saying, "Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath, or not?" 4 But they remained silent. Then he took him and healed him and sent him away. 5 And he said to them, "Which of you, having a son or an ox that has fallen into a well on a Sabbath day, will not immediately pull him out?" 6 And they could not reply to these things.

### **Jesus went to the hard places (Luke 14:1).**

Luke 4:31-37 – Jesus rebukes a demon on the Sabbath

Luke 4:38-40 – Jesus heals Simon's mother-in-law on the Sabbath

Luke 6:1-5 – Jesus' disciples pick grain on the Sabbath

Luke 6:6-11 – Jesus heals a man's hand on the Sabbath

Luke 13 – Jesus heals a disabled women on the Sabbath

### **Jesus cared for the suffering (Luke 14:2).**

### **Jesus is willing to listen to those who are against Him (Luke 14:3).**

### **Jesus transforms the lives of those who come to Him (Luke 14:4).**

### **Jesus exposes legalism and silences His enemies (14:5-6).**

### **Romans 3:19-20**

19 Now we know that whatever the law says it speaks to those who are under the law, so that every mouth may be stopped, and the whole world may be held accountable to God. 20 For by works of the law no human being will be justified in his sight, since through the law comes knowledge of sin.

### **Titus 3:4-6**

4 But when the goodness and loving kindness of God our Savior appeared, 5 he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit, 6 whom he poured out on us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior,
