

## Adoration/Praise

### I. We exist to praise God.

#### A. We exist for God's glory.

**<sup>7</sup> Everyone who is called by My name, And whom I have created for My glory, Whom I have formed, even whom I have made."** Isaiah 43:7 (NASB)

**<sup>5</sup> He predestined us to adoption as sons through Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the kind intention of His will, <sup>6</sup> to the praise of the glory of His grace, which He freely bestowed on us in the Beloved.** Ephesians 1:5-6

**<sup>11</sup> also we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to His purpose who works all things after the counsel of His will, <sup>12</sup> to the end that we who were the first to hope in Christ would be to the praise of His glory.** Ephesians 1:11-12

**<sup>13</sup> In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise, <sup>14</sup> who is given as a pledge of our inheritance, with a view to the redemption of *God's own* possession, to the praise of His glory.** Ephesians 1:13-14 (NASB)

#### B. Disciples continually praised God- Luke 24:53

#### C. All nations praise God.

**<sup>1</sup> Praise the Lord, all nations; Laud Him, all peoples!** Psalms 117:1 (NASB)

**<sup>10</sup> so that at the name of Jesus EVERY KNEE WILL BOW, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, <sup>11</sup> and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.** Philippians 2:10-11 (NASB)
