III. Boundaries for New Testament worship.

- Worship in spirit and in truth (John 4:23)

<sup>23</sup> "But an hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for such people the Father seeks to be His worshipers. John 4:23 (NASB)

1. Genuinely with heart engaged.
2. With humility

<sup>5</sup> You younger men, likewise, be subject to *your* elders; and all of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, for **GOD IS OPPOSED TO THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE HUMBLE.**

<sup>6</sup> Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you at the proper time, 1Peter 5:5-6 (NASB)

3. With the help of the Holy Spirit

<sup>3</sup> for we are the *true* circumcision, who worship in the Spirit of God and glory in Christ Jesus and put no confidence in the flesh, Philippians 3:3 (NASB)



4. The content of our worship needs to be true.
  5. I must be true or genuine in my worship.
- Worship in unity with your fellow believers.
    1. Be reconciled to your fellow believers.

**<sup>23</sup> "Therefore if you are presenting your offering at the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you, <sup>24</sup> leave your offering there before the altar and go; first be reconciled to your brother, and then come and present your offering. Matthew 5:23-24 (NASB)**

2. Care for you fellow believers (1 Cor. 11:20-30)
3. Gather with your fellow believers.

**<sup>19</sup> Therefore, brethren, since we have confidence to enter the holy place by the blood of Jesus, <sup>20</sup> by a new and living way which He inaugurated for us through the veil, that is, His flesh, <sup>21</sup> and since *we have* a great priest over the house of God, <sup>22</sup> let us draw near with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled *clean* from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. <sup>23</sup> Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful; <sup>24</sup> and let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds, <sup>25</sup> not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging *one another*; and all the more as you see the day drawing near.
