⁵ ~'Now then, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be My own possession among all the peoples, for all the earth is Mine; ⁶ and you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.' These are the words that you shall speak to the sons of Israel." Exodus 19:5-6 (NASB)

⁹ But you are A CHOSEN RACE, A royal PRIESTHOOD, A HOLY NATION, A PEOPLE FOR *God's* OWN POSSESSION, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; ¹⁰ for you once were NOT A PEOPLE, but now you are THE PEOPLE OF GOD; you had NOT RECEIVED MERCY, but now you have RECEIVED MERCY. ¹¹ Beloved, I urge you as aliens and strangers to abstain from fleshly lusts which wage war against the soul. ¹² Keep your behavior excellent among the Gentiles, so that in the thing in which they slander you as evildoers, they may because of your good deeds, as they observe *them*, glorify God in the day of visitation. 1 Peter 2:9-12 (NASB)

The consecration of Aaron and his sons:

- Done in public (Lev. 8:2-5)
- They were washed in water and Aaron was clothed in his priestly garments (Lev. 8:6-9)
- Moses anointed the tabernacle, altar, wash basin, and Aaron with oil (Lev. 8:10-12)
- Aaron's sons clothed (Lev. 8:13)
- Moses offered up a purification offering for Aaron and his sons (Lev. 8:14-17)

- Moses offered up a whole burnt offering for Aaron and his sons (Lev. 8:18)
- Moses offered a ram of ordination for Aaron and his sons for a wave offering and peace offering (Lev 8:22-32)
