Don't swear falsely by God's name (Lev. 19:12)



Don't seek supernatural guidance other than God's (Lev. 19:26, 31; 20:6, 27)

- Priests who approach God must be without physical, relational, or ceremonial defects (Leviticus 21-22)

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<sup>21</sup> "For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed the evil thoughts, fornications, thefts, murders, adulteries, <sup>22</sup> deeds of coveting *and* wickedness, *as well as* deceit, sensuality, envy, slander, pride *and* foolishness. <sup>23</sup> "All these evil things proceed from within and defile the man." Mark 7:21-23 (NASB)

<sup>12</sup> So then, my beloved, just as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your salvation with fear and trembling; <sup>13</sup> for it is God who is at work in you, both to will and to work for *His* good pleasure.
