1. What did it mean for the Jews to be baptized into Moses? What does it mean for us to be baptized into Christ?
2. What are some of the blessings we have in Christ?
3. Why does our security in Christ not protect us from all forms of God's judgment?
4. Paul gave five examples where the Jews craved evil things: idolatry, immorality, grumbling and complaining, rebelling against God-given authority. Which most tempts you and why?
5. Do you really believe you can seriously sin and fail in the Christian life? Why or why not?
6. Which promise in verse 13 do you most appreciate? Why?
7. How has God provided "ways of escape" for you in the past?
8. What "best practices" have you employed to minimize tempting thoughts?
9. What boundaries have you established to protect yourself from temptation in the following areas: sexual purity, gossip, worry, overeating, overspending.
