**DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

4. Do you agree with the conclusion that hospitality is the key to reaching people in our current cultural context? Why or why not?
5. What is one practical way can you start practicing more hospitality?
6. Is Jesus naturally overflowing in your life? Would the people who know you most agree with your assessment?
7. Think of one person you can ask to 'come and see' this week. Pray for the opportunity to show them Jesus so you can tell them about Jesus.
8. If you've never placed your faith in Jesus Christ and believed the gospel, is there anything from stopping you from doing it right now?
