Main Idea: We should support those who walk in truth in order to become fellow workers with the truth.

I. John rejoices that Gaius and others walk in the truth (vss 1-4).

II. Support those who go out for the sake of Jesus (vss 5-8).

III. Do not imitate dreadful Diotrephes who did not support traveling missionaries (vss 9-11).

IV. Delightful Demetrius is a good example to follow (vs 12).

V. Concluding remarks (vss 13-14).
