5. Do you suffer from mission drift? What is hardest for you: Mission Fatigue, Misplace Priorities, Marital Conflict or Misunderstood Calling?
6. What are the natural places that people congregate that you can fish at?
7. Who do you think the modern-day outcasts are? How can you reach them?
8. Have you trained those you disciple to fish in the presence of critics?
9. Are you know as a friend of sinners? What does that look like today?
